Tottenham Hotspur Stadium – Fan Familiarisation Event (Sunday 16 December 2018)

As part of the ongoing commissioning of the new stadium, Tottenham Hotspur Football Club will be holding a fan familiarisation event on Sunday 16 December 2018 from 11am – 3pm.

The event will allow up to 6,000 Season Ticket holders the chance to visit the south stand and north/south podium areas to familiarise themselves with their matchday journey, as well as helping the Club test the matchday security and stadium entry procedures. The event will be split across two entry times (11am – 1pm and 1pm – 3pm) with only 3,000 fans allowed within each time slot.

The Club intends to hold further Stadium events in the future, which will involve the local community.

Please note the following in relation to the event on **Sunday 16 December 2018**:

- As the Stadium is being promoted as a public transport venue, fans will be advised not to drive to the event and will be actively encouraged to use public transport.
- This is a low capacity event, therefore the Major Event Day measures outlined in the Blue Book will NOT be implemented. For example, there will be no Major Event Day CPZ in operation; no planned road closures and no shuttle buses in operation. However, the Club will have the capacity to close Park Lane, if required, to maintain pedestrian and vehicle safety.
- 'No Waiting' cones will be placed along both sides of Park Lane to discourage fans from parking in potentially busy areas throughout the event period.
- Local residents should also be aware that Northumberland Park Station will be closed all day and White Hart Lane Station will be closed for planned engineering works until approximately 10.30am.

The Club's Community Relations Team will be in attendance on the day to monitor the event.
